By low or high use of electronic devices for leisure during the school day

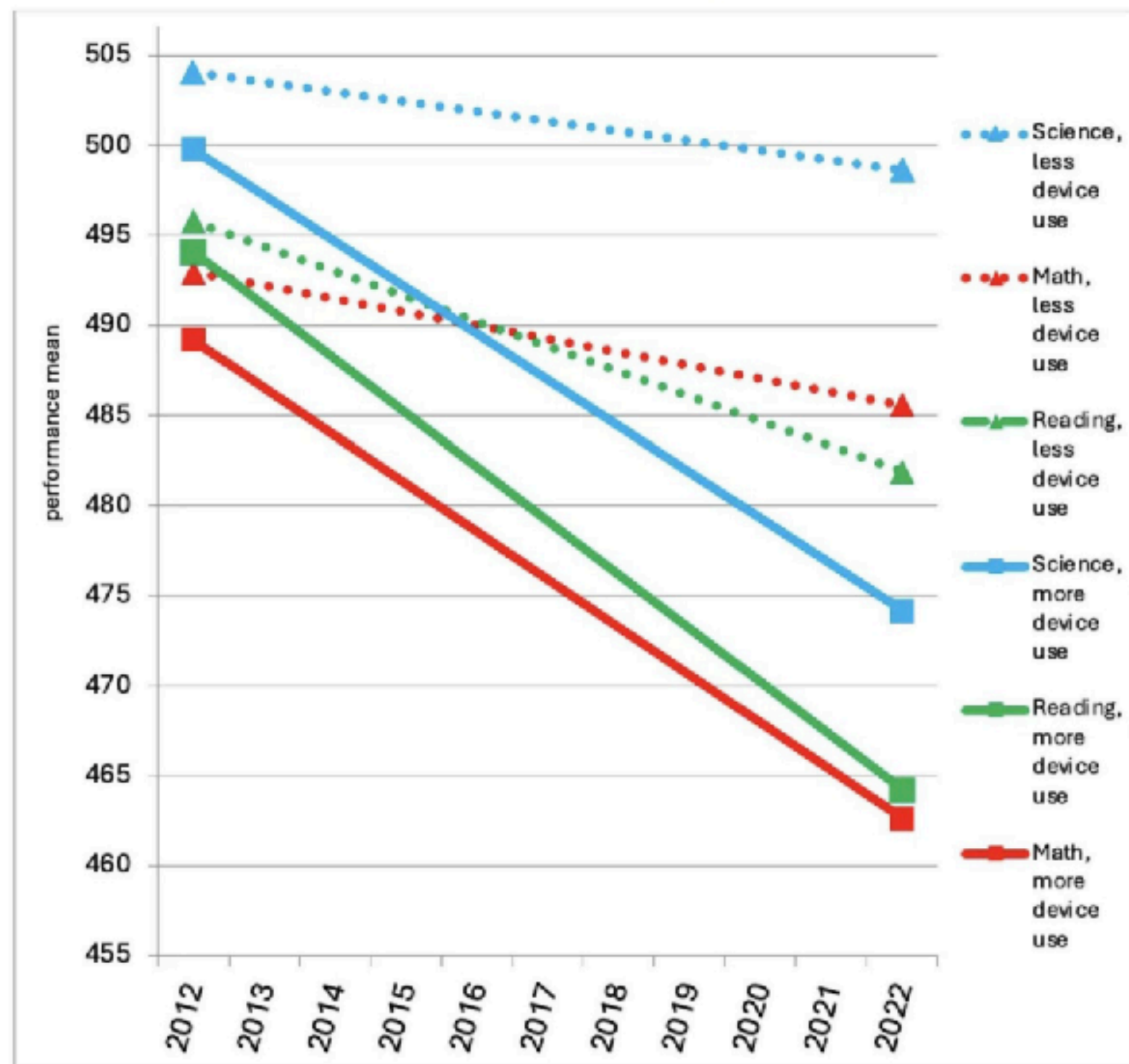


Figure 1: Scores on standardized tests of math, reading, and science for 15- and 16-year-olds in 36 countries, by low or high use of electronic devices for leisure during the school day. Note: Controlled for GDP per capita. Source: Twenge (2025), using data from PISA.

“They’re the first generation in modern history to score lower on standardized academic tests than the one before it,” Dr. Jared Cooney Horvath, 43, “They underperformed on basically every cognitive measure, from basic attention, memory, literacy, numeracy, executive function and general IQ.”

So what happened that caused an entire age group to bomb test scores?

Horvath, who studied reams of data from standardized academic tests, told Congress that Z’s struggles stem from the fact that they’re the first generation to grow up with constant screen time. And it’s no substitute for real learning.

3 Key Reasons To Take The Digital SAT & ACT



#1: SAT & ACT Scores Impact Admissions At “Test-Optional” Colleges

Acceptance rates at **test-optional colleges** are significantly higher (**often 2-3x**) for students who submit test scores than for students who do not.



#2: SAT & ACT Scores Impact Merit-Based Scholarships

If your student does not have a test score, you will not be considered for **billions of dollars in scholarships** from colleges and private companies.



#3: SAT & ACT Scores Required Again At Most Top Universities

Most top colleges have reinstated SAT & ACT score requirements for admission, including at all Ivy League universities (except one).

Does That Mean The Digital SAT & ACT Are Easier?

Digital SAT & ACT Are Easier Than Before, But By No Means “Easy”

- **“Adaptive” Test:** The first modules assess baseline performance level. Based on answers, second modules adapt their difficulty to your skill level.
- If did well in the 1st module, 2nd module will have harder questions.
- The adaptive test calculates an accurate score with fewer questions.
- **Remember!** The Digital SAT & ACT are standardized tests **based on a curve**. If it is “easy” for most students, you have less room for error in order to get a high score, and scores drop quickly even if you just miss a few questions!

- **Test** to see which answer choice works!

High School Math & Khan Academy

Avoid Extreme “-ly” Adverbs in SAT & ACT Reading

Answers with extreme adverbs are incorrect on SAT & ACT Reading

- An adverb modifies a verb, an adjective, or another adverb
- Typically, adverbs end in the suffix “-ly”
- “Extreme adverbs” signal a significant degree or extent of something
- Answers that contain extreme adverbs are often incorrect

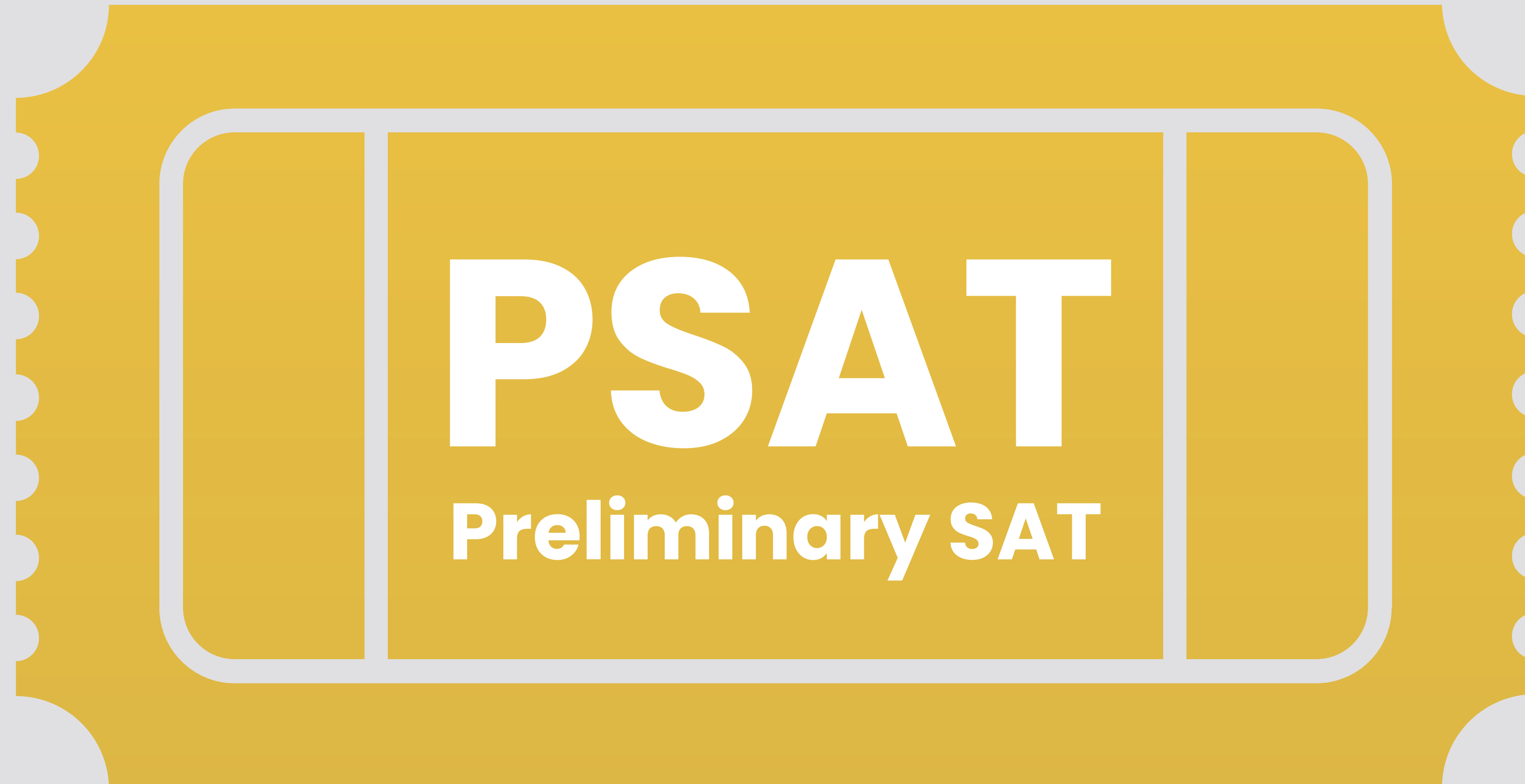

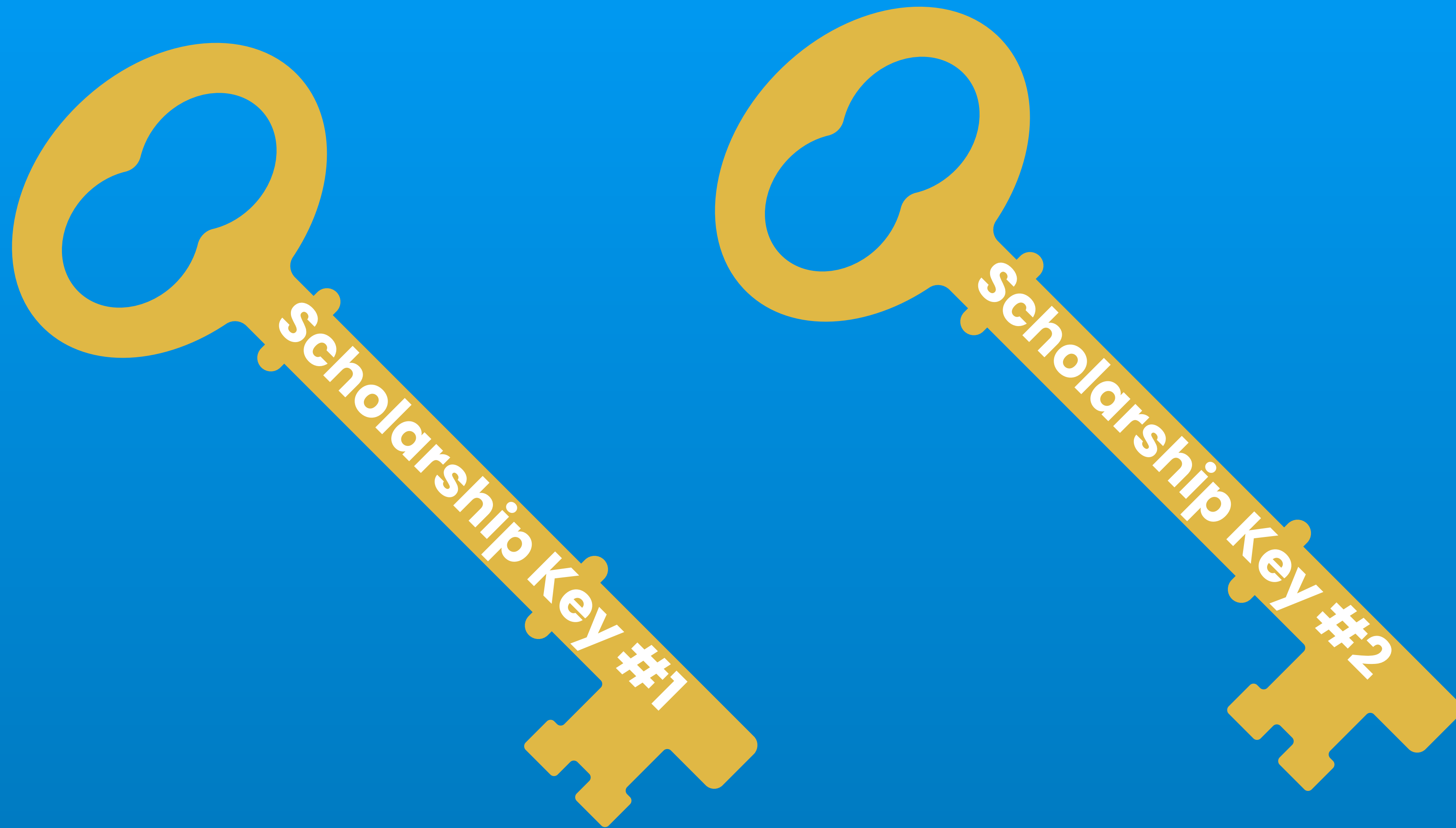

Scholarship Key #1: Apply To Local Scholarships

Apply for scholarships local to your city or state

- National Scholarships often have 100,000+ applications (i.e. Lottery)
- Local Scholarships → Fewer Applications → Higher Chance of Winning
- Search for local scholarships in your area (city and state) on Google
- Local Scholarships do not mean you need to go to in-state for college

Key #2: Apply To Colleges Offering Merit-Based Scholarships

It is a mistake if you only apply to the Ivy League Universities!

- Why? Ivy League Universities do not offer merit-based scholarships
- If your family does not qualify for need-based aid, you get \$0 from Ivies.
- You must also apply to colleges that offer merit-based scholarships!
- Most of the time, there is no separate application for merit scholarships
- High school seniors with good grades, test scores, and extracurriculars are often just automatically offered half-tuition and full-tuition scholarships!

By low or high use of electronic devices for leisure during the school day

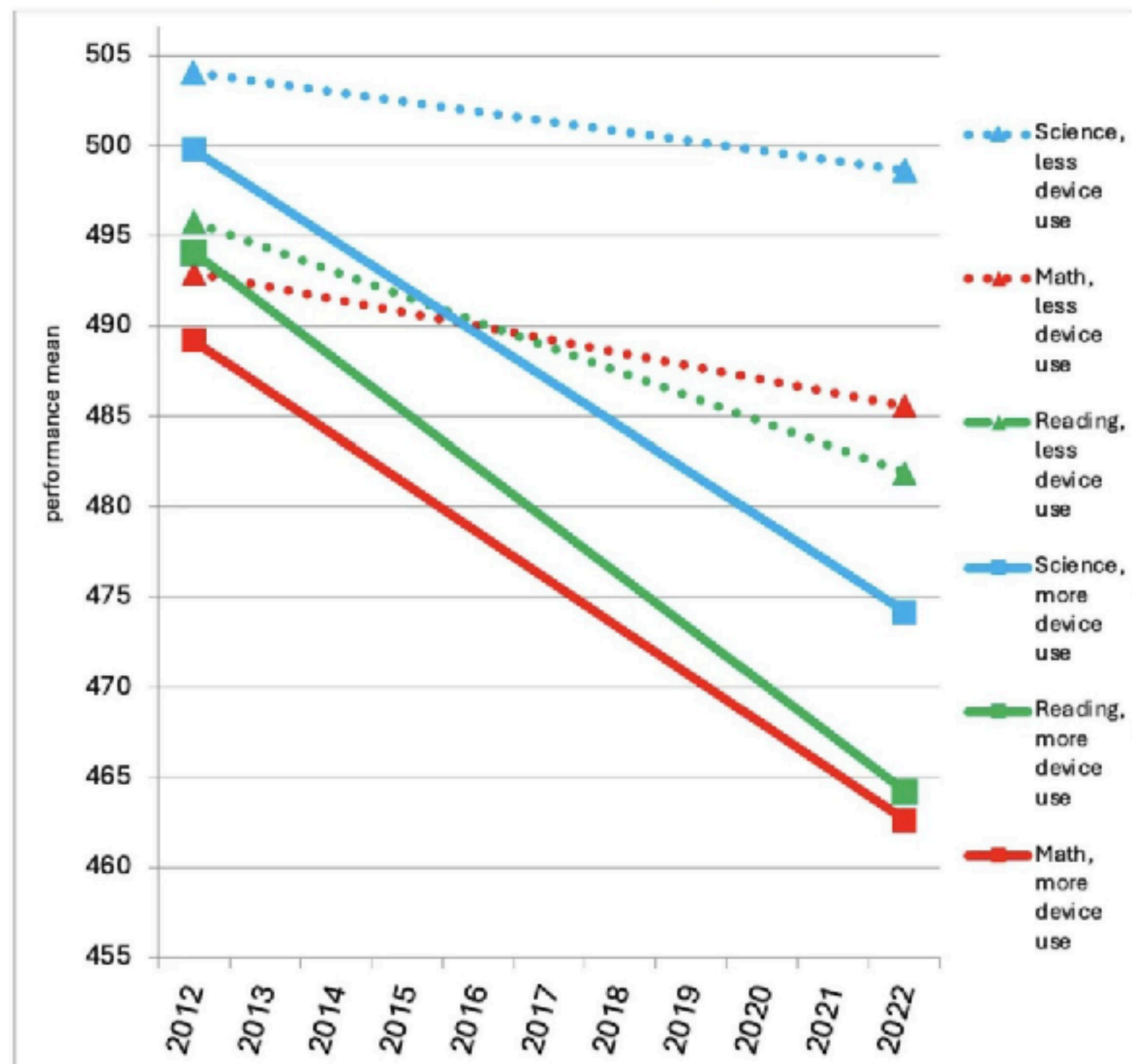


Figure 1: Scores on standardized tests of math, reading, and science for 15- and 16-year-olds in 36 countries, by low or high use of electronic devices for leisure during the school day. Note: Controlled for GDP per capita. Source: Twenge (2025), using data from PISA.

“They’re the first generation in modern history to score lower on standardized academic tests than the one before it,” Dr. Jared Cooney Horvath, 43,

“They underperformed on basically every cognitive measure, from basic attention, memory, literacy, numeracy, executive function and general IQ.”

So what happened that caused an entire age group to bomb test scores?

Horvath, who studied reams of data from standardized academic tests, told Congress that Z’s struggles stem from the fact that they’re the first generation to grow up with constant screen time. And it’s no substitute for real learning.
